Building Literacy and Numeracy when travelling.

Pre-school to Stage 1

- 4 Play license plate games by making up words from the letters; or add the numbers
- Count telegraph poles or signs
- 4 Play Spotto list twenty items the child needs to 'spot' or discover.
- 4 Discuss the shape of road signs. Discuss what different symbols mean.
- Wake up stories or histories about street names of relocations.
- Guess the colour of the next car to appear around the corner. Change this to every third car.
- Give each child a colour to count and tally the number of car between two points. Then change it to trucks.
- 🖊 Listen to stories on a CD or I-pod or sing songs or clap out the rhythm

Stage 2 and Stage 3

- Use public transport and look for times and destinations. Count the number of train stations or bus stops to your destination. Look at the route on a map.
- Estimate how many minutes it will take to reach the next town if you are travelling at 60 kilometres an hour.
- Keep a diary on long trips. Cut out pictures from brochures of each town and record thoughts and reactions about each one.




