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Kindergarten have been investigating how they move. Now they have been describing how their toys from home move. They had lots of fun playing and manipulating everyone's toys.







Stage 1 are looking at the properties of cooked and uncooked food. What happens to corn kernels and chocolate when they are heated? Can we return them to how they looked before?





Stage 2 are investigating rocks and soil. They have been bringing in samples from home for their peers to take a close look at. Some have even been professionally labelled \odot . From here we have filled up their jars with water and let them settle so that they could observe the different layers of soil and matter present in their samples. We drew labelled diagrams to scale.









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Stage 3 have been feeling trembles under their feet! Continuing on from plate tectonics, students completed interactive activities looking at plate movements and joining up the plates as one large jigsaw puzzle.

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IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PARENTS

Re: Whooping Cough - Public Health alert

There has been an increase of whooping cough (Pertussis) notifications in the Western Sydney area since June 2014, particularly in the 2155 postcode area.

In order to prevent further cases of whooping cough Western Sydney Public Health Unit advises the following:

If your child (or any member of your family) has any of the symptoms of whooping cough, such as a dry or persistent cough, which may be especially bad at night, please see your doctor and take this notice with you. A nose and throat swab test can be performed to confirm the diagnosis.

If your child has whooping cough, your doctor will arrange a course of antibiotic treatment. Antibiotics given early in the illness are effective in stopping the cough and in preventing spread to other people. If your doctor diagnoses whooping cough please advise the school and keep your child at home until s/he has taken 5 days of antibiotics.
